

STUDY OVERVIEW:

State Route 189 (locally known as Mariposa Road) is a 3.75-mile, Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) maintained highway in the City of Nogales in Santa Cruz County, Arizona.

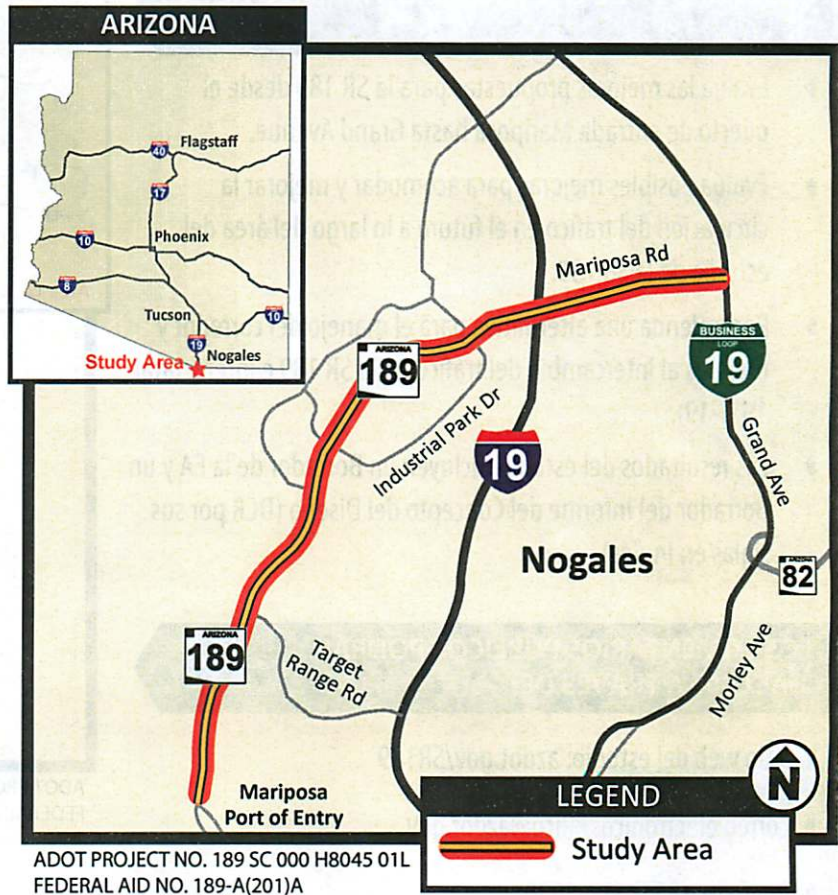
The Mariposa Port of Entry, one of the busiest cargo ports along the U.S./Mexico border, has recently been expanded, and increased travel demand along the route is anticipated. ADOT and the Federal Highway Administration are working on a study evaluating roadway and traffic improvements on SR 189 from the U.S./Mexico border to Grand Avenue.

THE SR 189 DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

- ▶ Evaluates proposed improvements to SR 189 from the Mariposa Port of Entry to Grand Avenue.
- ▶ Assesses proposed improvements to accommodate and improve future traffic flow throughout the SR 189 study area.
- ▶ Recommends a Corridor Management Alternative for improving the SR 189 corridor, along with improvements at the SR 189 and Interstate 19 (I-19) traffic interchange.
- ▶ Deliverables include a Draft EA and Draft Design Concept Report (DCR).
