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UNDERSTANDING THE PROBATE PROCESS

A QUICK INTRODUCTION FOR FAMILIES AND EXECUTORS

Losing a loved one is difficult enough without the added pressure of navigating the probate process. Whether you've been named as the executor or are just trying to understand what probate entails, it's important to know the key concepts.

Probate is the legal process of settling an estate after someone passes. The court oversees the process to ensure debts are paid, taxes are filed, and remaining assets are distributed according to the will—or state law if there is no will.

WHY PROBATE MATTERS

Probate ensures that:

- ✓ The deceased person's wishes (in their will) are followed.
- ✓ Creditors and the government get paid.
- ✓ Assets are legally transferred to the rightful beneficiaries.
- ✓ The estate is handled in an organized, legal, and transparent way.

While every estate is different, understanding the basics can help you make informed decisions and avoid costly mistakes.

KEY CONCEPTS YOU MAY KNOW BUT REALLY NEED TO UNDERSTAND



Probate: The legal process of settling an estate after someone passes.



Executor/Administrator: The person responsible for handling the estate's affairs, both legally and financially.



Beneficiaries: The people or entities who will receive assets from the estate.



Testate vs. Intestate: With a will (testate) the estate is distributed according to the will. Without a will (intestate), state law determines who inherits.



Court Approval: Some actions, including selling real estate, may require court approval.



KEY TAKEAWAY: Probate can feel overwhelming, but you don't have to navigate it alone. Knowledge, the right team, and clear guidance can make the process smoother.



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KEY ROLES IN THE PROBATE PROCESS



UNDERSTANDING WHO DOES WHAT AND WHY IT MATTERS

Probate involves several key people, each with important responsibilities. Understanding these roles can help ensure the process runs smoothly and the estate is handled properly.



DECEDENT

The person who has passed away and whose estate is being settled.



PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE (EXECUTOR OR ADMINISTRATOR)

The person appointed by the court to manage the estate, pay debts and taxes, and distribute assets according to the will—or state law if there is no will.



THE COURT

Oversees the probate process, approves key actions, and ensures everything is handled according to Michigan law.



CREDITORS & GOVERNMENT

Entities that must be paid from the estate, including outstanding debts, taxes, and final bills.



BENEFICIARIES

The people or organizations who will receive assets from the estate after all obligations are met.

THE PROBATE PROCESS AT A GLANCE

1



FILE PETITION

The Personal Representative files a petition with the probate court to open the estate.

2



COURT APPOINTMENT

The court reviews the petition and officially appoints the Personal Representative.

3



INVENTORY & NOTICE

The estate's assets are identified, and notice is given to heirs and creditors.

4



PAY DEBTS & TAXES

The Personal Representative pays valid debts, taxes, and final expenses.

5



MANAGE & LIQUIDATE ASSETS

Assets may be managed, sold, or otherwise handled in the best interest of the estate.

6



DISTRIBUTE ASSETS

Remaining assets are distributed to beneficiaries according to the will—or state law.

7



CLOSE ESTATE

A final accounting is filed with the court and the estate is officially closed.

CONSIDERATIONS

- ✓ Requires listing with a real estate agent
- ✓ Showings, open houses, and ongoing marketing
- ✓ Repairs or updates may be needed
- ✓ Agent commissions and closing costs apply
- ✓ Market conditions can impact time and price
- ✓ Typically takes 30–90 days or longer to close
- ✓ Court approval may be required for the sale in some cases



TIP: A traditional sale may be the best choice when the property is in good condition, there is no rush to sell, or maximizing value is the top goal.

COMMON PROBATE MISTAKES



1. DELAYING THE PROCESS

Waiting too long to start probate can lead to missed deadlines, late fees, and unnecessary stress. Start the process as soon as possible.



2. NOT FILING PROPERLY

Incorrect or incomplete paperwork can cause delays or even rejection. Make sure all documents are accurate and complete.



3. POOR COMMUNICATION

4. OVERLOOKING DEBTS AND TAXES

All valid debts, claims, and taxes must be paid before assets can be distributed. Overlooking these can create legal and financial problems.

Selling assets without court approval (when required) or failing to get the best value can be a breach of fiduciary duty.
